



Public Transit Service Areas in Metro Vancouver Region
 This map has been modified by Matt Todd for the Kwantlen Student Association to illustrate approximate walking distance to public transit routes. The green areas are less than 5 minutes from a bus route (250m). The yellow areas are less than 15 minutes from a bus route (1000m). The remaining areas are in excess of one kilometre from a bus route, considered an unreasonable walking distance for providing a transportation alternative to the private automobile. These areas are deemed to be outside the Translink service area for students traveling to Kwantlen Polytechnic University campuses. The shaded areas highlight postal code regions (FSAs) which may contain unserved residences. Those shaded darker are likely to have a vast majority of residences beyond the true operational service area of public transit. The numbers indicate the number of Kwantlen Polytechnic University students who were residents of that postal code FSA in 2009.
